The service request form continues to have the space to check “Perform all services as needed” to care for the boat. If you perform some of the winterization tasks yourself, you can check off the services we need to perform for you. Even if you like to winterize the boat yourself consider how nice it would be to have that space back in the garage—just drop off the boat in the fall and pick it up in the spring!
